The Future at Pinal a Success

Last Fall, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors hired the Morrison Institute to examine how other counties have responded to growth, conduct interviews with leaders and residents, and explore possible futures for Pinal. The result of this effort, *The Future at Pinal: Making Choices, Making Places*, was presented on July 3, 2007, to a crowd of more than 300 at The Property conference center in Casa Grande. *The Future at Pinal* is the first step in a continuing county-wide dialogue that will take place during the Comprehensive Plan effort.

The release of this exciting report launches the Comprehensive Plan into its first set of public involvement activities. Road Shows will be hosted throughout Pinal County starting July 9; these events will discuss future growth and development of the County. People are invited to participate in one or more of the Road Shows. The information presented will be the same at each event, but due to the dynamics of the various locations and participants, the dialogue will vary. The Consulting Team will present Pinal County "Realities and Opportunities" and facilitate a dialogue about resident's visions and ideas.
